WHEREAS, health care professionals, first responders and caregivers are ready to aid the people of Wyoming 24 hours a day, seven days a week; and

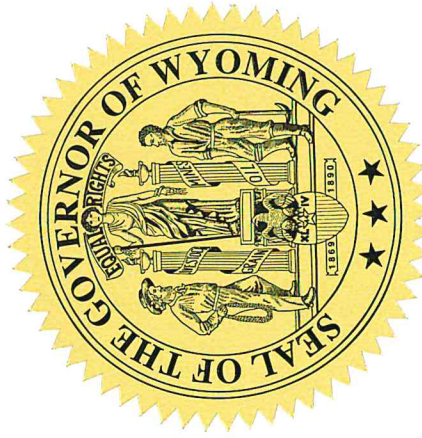
WHEREAS, the people of Wyoming owe our health care professionals, first responders and caregivers a debt of gratitude for their hard work and sacrifice during this pandemic;
